

### SMEs across Europe







- 99.8% of all businesses
- > 20 million SMEs in Europe
- 67% of all jobs
- 57% of the gross value added
- More than 1500 EU standardsdelivered every year

- Follow-up & comment on policies related to standardisation
- Observer in the European Commission Committee of Standards & participation in Commission Expert Groups



# Call for experts 2022



### General information

- Open call for experts to represent SMEs in TCs, SCs and WGs of CEN, CENELEC, ETSI, ISO, IEC & ITU.
- Open to candidates with technical expertise in any standardisation topic relevant for SMEs; applications for some topics particularly welcome (see Annex 3)
- Co-funded by the EU Commission and EFTA Member States
- Appointment for one year (renewable)
- Deadline for applications: 19 September 2021

# Tasks to be performed by the experts



### Experts' Tasks

- Represent the European SME position in TCs and/or WGs
- Attend TC/SC/WG meetings (willingness to travel) and contribution to the work by submitting comments/proposals...
- Report to SBS expert coordinator: 1 Action Plan & 2 Activity reports
- Participate in relevant SBS Working Groups to exchange with other experts and agree on the European SME position or set up your own Mirror Committee
- Participate in Expert Meetings (at least in 1 of the meetings organised per year)
- Contribute to SBS newsletter and other activities (as required)



# Eligibility and selection criteria





- Residence in the EU or EFTA countries
- Application to be backed by a recognised SME association
- Agreement to co-fund of a part of the lump sum paid to the expert
   (€ 1,278 / € 2,177)
- Absence of double-funding and of conflict of interest (declaration to be signed)
- Any current mandate to be compatible with becoming SBS expert

### Selection criteria (I)



- SME/craft oriented background
- Technical expertise of subject in scope of the relevant TC/SC/WG
- Importance of the proposed TC/SC/WG for SMEs
- Excellent knowledge of English (written and verbal)
- Knowledge of the standardisation system
- Communication, negotiation skills and computer literacy

### Selection criteria (II)



- Re-applying experts: quality of work, timely delivery of reports and participation/organisation in SBS WGs/mirror committees
- Application should include at least a WG (unless TC/SC does not have WGs)
- Maximum 1 expert per WG- but different experts can be appointed to different WGs under the same TC/SC.
- A second TC/SC(s)/WG(s) can be indicated as a second preference



# Content of the application

### New applicants (I)

- Use Application form in Annex 1
- Contact details
- Number and title of the TC/SC/WG the applicant is applying for- a second choice can be indicated
- Indicative list of meetings of the TCs/SCs/WGs
- Motivation and justification of the importance for SMEs
- Details of recognised SME organisation supporting the application

## New applicants (II)



- Details on how the applicant meets selection criteria (knowledge standardisation system, technical expertise on TC/SC/WG subject...)
- Who is providing the co-funding
- Type of contract (paid at European or International level or unpaid)
- Person/organisation signing the contract and whether person/organisation is VAT registered
- Signed declaration of honour
- Attachments: Letter of support recognised SME association & Applicant CV

### Re-applying 2021 SBS experts

- Use Application form in Annex 2
- Similar information like for new applicants but...
- No need to provide detailed description of skills and expertise except if new TC/SC/WG
- Attachment: Letter of support recognised SME association
- The submission of an updated CV is optional

## Unfunded experts



- The tasks, work planning and reporting activities remain the same as for funded experts
- The application requirements remain the same-clearly indicate for which appointments applicants are/are not seeking funding



# Contract and co-funding

## Contract and co-funding (I)



- One year contract (January December 2022)
- Unfunded contracts possible
- Lump sum of € 9 600 (European technical bodies) or € 16 350 (international technical bodies)
- All expenses of the expert during the year are covered by the lump sum
- Experts can only receive one lump sum (even if several appointments)

### Contract and co-funding (II)



- Conditional to co-funding pre-payment of € 1 278 (European) or € 2 177 (international)
- The contract will be either concluded:
  - between SBS and the SME supporting association supported experts
  - between SBS and the expert directly independent experts
- Candidates shall indicate in their application the type of contract sought
